DIGEST OF SB 258 (Updated February 20, 2020 10:48 am - DI 128)

Citations Affected: IC 36-8.

Synopsis: Firefighter safety. Requires the board of firefighting personnel standards and education to establish best practices to improve safety and health outcomes for firefighters. Establishes the best practices fund for the purpose of providing matching grants to political subdivisions and volunteer fire departments to purchase equipment and other gear to implement best practices.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in this style type, and deletions will appear in this style type.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or *this style type* reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 258

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 36-8-10.5-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 11. (a) The education board must
4	establish best practices to improve safety and health outcomes for
5	full-time firefighters and volunteer firefighters not later than July
6	1, 2021.
7	(b) The best practices must include:
8	(1) a proactive health and safety risk management system
9	consisting of a joint employer and employee governance
10	structure to oversee a continuous process of identification,
11	evaluation, monitoring and controlling, and reporting safety
12	and health hazards in the workplace;
13	(2) ways to reduce firefighter risk of exposure to carcinogens;
14	and
15	(3) ways to prevent or reduce the risk of injuries and illness
16	with particular focus on causes of compensable worker's
17	compensation or disability claims.



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SECTION 2. IC 36-8-10.5-12 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA 1 2 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS 3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 12. (a) The best practices fund is 4 established for the purpose of providing matching grants to 5 political subdivisions and volunteer fire departments to purchase 6 equipment and other gear to implement best practices established 7 under section 11 of this chapter. 8 (b) The fund shall be administered by the education board. 9 (c) The fund consists of: 10 (1) appropriations from the general assembly; and 11 (2) amounts deposited from any other public or private 12 source. 13 (d) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund. 14 15 (e) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not currently needed to meet obligations of the fund in the same 16 17 manner as other public money may be invested. Interest that 18 accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund. 19 (f) Money in the fund at the end of the state fiscal year does not 20 revert to the state general fund. 21 (g) The education board shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to 22 implement this section.
