

SENATE BILL No. 273

DIGEST OF SB 273 (Updated January 30, 2019 3:17 pm - DI 106)

Citations Affected: IC 31-26.

Synopsis: Kids first trust fund board subsidiary corporation. Allows the Indiana kids first trust fund board to create a nonprofit subsidiary corporation.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

SENATE BILL No. 273

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- SECTION 1. IC 31-26-4-5, AS ADDED BY P.L.145-2006, SECTION 272, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 5. (a) The Indiana kids first trust fund board is established.
- (b) The purpose of the board is to determine whether proposed projects under this chapter should be approved and to perform other duties given to the board by this chapter. The board shall approve projects and recommend to the department that the projects receive funds under sections 12 and 14 of this chapter.
- (c) The board shall, before January 1 of each year, prepare a budget for expenditures from the fund for the following state fiscal year. The budget must contain priorities for expenditures from the fund to accomplish the projects that have been approved under this chapter. The budget shall be submitted to the department and the budget committee.
- (d) The board may employ staff necessary to carry out the duties of the board.

6	fund is established to carry out the purposes of this chapter.

10	(3) Fees from kids first trust license plates issued under
11	IC 9-18-30 (before its expiration) or IC 9-18.5-14.
12	(4) Money donated to the fund, including donations from a
13	subsidiary corporation established under section 17 of this

15	(5) Money transferred to the fund from other funds.
16	(c) The treasurer of state shall administer the fund.
17	(d) The expenses of administering the fund and this chapter shall be
18	paid from the fund.
19	(e) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
20	currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
21	manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that accrues
22	from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.
23	(f) An appropriation made by the general assembly to the fund shall
24	be allotted and allocated at the beginning of the fiscal period for which
25	the appropriation was made.
26	(g) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert
27	to the state general fund or any other fund.
28	(h) Subject to this chapter, there is annually appropriated to the
29	department all money in the fund for the purposes of this chapter.
30	However, the department may not request the allotment of money from
31	the appropriation for a project that has not been approved and
32	recommended by the board.
33	SECTION 3. IC 31-26-4-17 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
34	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
35	1, 2019]: Sec. 17. (a) The board may establish a nonprofit
36	subsidiary corporation that is exempt from federal income taxation
37	under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to solicit and
38	accept private funding, gifts, donations, bequests, devises, and
39	contributions.
40	(b) A subsidiary corporation established under this section:

(1) shall use money received under subsection (a) to carry out in any manner the purposes and programs of the board,

1	including programs intended to reduce infant mortality,
2	increase childhood immunizations, and reduce child abuse
3	and neglect;
4	(2) shall report to the budget committee each year
5	concerning:
6	(A) the use of money received under subsection (a); and
7	(B) the balances in any accounts or funds established by
8	the subsidiary corporation;
9	(3) may donate money received under subsection (a) to the
10	Indiana kids first trust fund; and
11	(4) may deposit money received under subsection (a) in an
12	account or fund that is:
13	(A) administered by the subsidiary corporation; and
14	(B) not part of the state treasury.
15	(c) A subsidiary corporation established under this section is
16	governed by a board of directors comprised of members appointed
17	by the board. Employees of the Indiana kids first trust fund board
18	may serve on the board of directors of the subsidiary corporation.
19	(d) Employees of the board shall provide administrative support
20	for a subsidiary corporation established under this section.
21	Employees of the board directly involved in the subsidiary
22	corporation established under this section may engage in
23	fundraising activities on behalf of the subsidiary corporation.
24	(e) The state board of accounts shall annually audit a subsidiary
25	corporation established under this section.
