

SENATE BILL No. 283

DIGEST OF SB 283 (Updated February 21, 2019 11:30 am - DI 125)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: State payments in lieu of property taxes. Urges the legislative council to assign to an appropriate interim study committee the task of studying the topic of state payments in lieu of property taxes to counties in which at least 15% of all land in the county is: (1) in the aggregate, owned or leased by the state of Indiana or the federal government; and (2) subject to an exemption from property taxes.

Effective: Upon passage.

Houchin

SENATE BILL No. 283

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) The legislative
2	council is urged to assign to an appropriate interim study
3	committee the task of studying the topic of state payments in lieu
4	of property taxes to counties in which at least fifteen percent (15%)
5	of all land in the county is:
6	(1) in the aggregate, owned or leased by the state of Indiana
7	or the federal government; and
8	(2) subject to an exemption from property taxes.
9	(b) This SECTION expires December 31, 2019.
10	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
