# **SENATE BILL No. 319**

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-28-5-25.

**Synopsis:** Practitioner or accomplished practitioner license. Provides that 15 of the professional growth experience points required to renew a practitioner license or accomplished practitioner license may be obtained through one or more of certain professional development experiences. (Current law requires 15 of the professional growth experience points to renew a practitioner license or an accomplished practitioner license must be obtained through one or more of certain development experiences.) Amends the list of professional development experiences.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

### **SENATE BILL No. 319**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-28-5-25, AS ADDED BY P.L.143-2019, SECTION 20, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 25. (a) This section applies to a professional growth plan that begins after July 1, 2019.

(b) Fifteen (15) of the total number of professional growth experience points required to renew a practitioner license or an accomplished practitioner license must may be obtained through the completion of one (1) or more of the following:

9 (1) An externship with a company. Working for or with a local 10 company in a capacity that includes an understanding of the 11 current and future economic needs of the company and 12 community and a process to disseminate that information to 13 students.

(2) Professional development provided by the state, a local
business, or a community partner that provides opportunities for
schools and employers to partner in promoting career navigation,
including local business professionals communicating directly



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1	to students as guest speakers in the classroom.
2	(3) Professional development provided by the state, a local
3	business, or a community partner that outlines the:
4	(A) current and future economic needs of the community,
5	state, nation, and globe; and
6	(B) ways in which the current and future economic needs
7	described in clause (A) can be disseminated to students.
8	(4) Participation in mentoring or coaching students who are
9	involved in, working with students who are involved in, and
10	exposing students to real world competitions or any other
11	types of programs that provide career skills, including
12	competitions or programs involving or provided by the
13	following:
14	(A) Robotics.
15	(B) Tests of Engineering Aptitude, Mathematics and
16	Science (TEAMS).
17	(C) Technology Student Association (TSA).
18	(D) Future Health Professionals (HOSA).
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19 (E) Distributive Education Clubs of America (DECA).
