

SENATE BILL No. 319

DIGEST OF SB 319 (Updated January 29, 2020 5:42 pm - DI 110)

Citations Affected: IC 20-28.

Synopsis: Practitioner or accomplished practitioner license. Provides that 15 of the professional growth experience points required to renew a practitioner license or accomplished practitioner license may be obtained through one or more of certain professional development experiences. (Current law requires 15 of the professional growth experience points to renew a practitioner license or an accomplished practitioner license must be obtained through one or more of certain professional development experiences.) Amends the list of professional development experiences.

Effective: Upon passage.

Rogers, Becker, Raatz, Buchanan, Leising, Donato, Spartz

January 13, 2020, read first time and referred to Committee on Education and Career Development.

January 30, 2020, amended, reported favorably — Do Pass.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-28-5-25, AS ADDED BY P.L.143-2019,
SECTION 20, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 25. (a) This section applies to a professional
growth plan that begins after July 1, 2019.
(b) Fifteen (15) of the total number of professional growth

- (b) Fifteen (15) of the total number of professional growth experience points required to renew a practitioner license or an accomplished practitioner license must may be obtained through the completion of one (1) or more of the following:
 - (1) An externship with a company. Working for or with a local company in a capacity that includes an understanding of the current and future economic needs of the company and community and a process to disseminate that information to students.
 - (2) Professional development provided by the state, a local business, or a community partner that provides opportunities for schools and employers to partner in promoting career navigation, including local business professionals communicating directly
