DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-26-4-12.

Synopsis: School board member training. Adds a definition of "training course" for purposes of the training requirement that is applicable to the members of a school corporation's governing body. Provides that the department of education (department) shall work with the department of local government finance and the Indiana education employment relations board to create the training course. Provides that, beginning after December 31, 2020, each newly elected or appointed member of a school corporation's governing body shall attend the training course created by the department. Provides that reelected and reappointed members of a governing body are required to attend the training if at least four years have passed after the date on which the individual's term ended. Provides that a school corporation may pay the training expenses of a member of the governing body from the school corporation's operations fund without appropriation.

- (4) How to access academic and financial data and information related to school corporations that is maintained by the department.
- (5) Sources of state funding available to school corporations.
- (c) Except as provided in subsection (f), an individual who becomes a member after December 31, 2020, shall complete a training course not later than six (6) months after becoming a member.
 - (d) The format of the training may be either an:
 - (1) in-person presentation at a location the department selects; or
 - (2) electronic or technology based medium, including self-review modules available on an online system.
- (e) This subsection applies only to an individual who has previously served a term as a member of a governing body. If an individual is reelected or reappointed to a governing body following a lapse of at least four (4) years after the date on which the individual's term ended, the individual shall attend the training course established by this section.
- (f) This subsection applies only to an individual appointed to fill a vacancy on the governing body. An individual described in this subsection may, but is not required to, take the training course required by this section. If an individual described in this subsection takes a training course required by this section for a member of a governing body, the school corporation shall pay for the training course as if the individual had been newly elected or appointed to the governing body.
- (g) Expenses incurred for a training course by an individual who takes office as a newly elected or appointed member of the governing body after December 31, 2020, may be paid from the school corporation's operations fund without appropriation.
