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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 11-14.

**Synopsis:** Repeal of youth offender boot camp program. Repeals the boot camp for youthful offenders article.

**Effective:** July 1, 2020.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*
