

SENATE BILL No. 374

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-7-6-7; IC 35-46-1-11.9; IC 35-52-7-97.

Synopsis: E-liquid and electronic cigarette crimes. Provides that a person who knowingly or intentionally sells an e-liquid or an electronic cigarette that contains: (1) a concentration of nicotine that is more than 20 milligrams per milliliter; or (2) contains vitamin E acetate; commits a Class C misdemeanor.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-7-6-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2020]: **Sec. 7. (a) A person who knowingly or intentionally sells**
4 **an e-liquid that contains a concentration of nicotine that is more**
5 **than twenty (20) milligrams per milliliter commits a Class C**
6 **misdeemeanor.**

7 **(b) A person who knowingly or intentionally sells an e-liquid**
8 **that contains vitamin E acetate commits a Class C misdemeanor.**

9 SECTION 2. IC 35-46-1-11.9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
10 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
11 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: **Sec. 11.9. (a) A person who knowingly**
12 **or intentionally sells an electronic cigarette that contains a**
13 **concentration of nicotine that is more than twenty (20) milligrams**
14 **per milliliter commits a Class C misdemeanor.**

15 **(b) A person who knowingly or intentionally sells an electronic**
16 **cigarette that contains vitamin E acetate commits a Class C**
17 **misdeemeanor.**

2 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2020]: **Sec. 97. IC 7.1-7-6-7 defines crimes concerning e-liquid.**
