DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 33-33-10.

Synopsis: Clark County circuit court. Establishes the Clark circuit courts No. 5 and No. 6, beginning January 1, 2025. Provides for the election of the judges of each of these circuit courts at the November 2024 general election. Establishes the Clark superior courts No. 4 and No. 5. Requires the governor to appoint the judge of each of these superior courts. Provides that each of these superior courts converts to Clark circuit courts No. 5 and No. 6 beginning January 1, 2025.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

(B) minor offenses and violations docket.

(b) A judge of the superior court may, with the consent of a judge of the circuit court, transfer any action or proceeding from that superior court to that circuit court.

(c) A judge of the superior court may, with the consent of the judge of the other superior court, transfer any action or proceeding from that superior court to the other superior court.

(d) A judge of the circuit court may, with the consent of a judge of the superior court, sit as a judge of that superior court in any matter, as if the judge were judge of that superior court.

(e) A judge of the superior court may, with consent of a judge of 32 the circuit court, sit as a judge of that circuit court as if the judge 33 were judge of the circuit court.

34 (f) A judge of the superior court may, with the consent of the 35 judge of the other superior court, sit as judge of the other superior 36 court as if the judge of that superior court.
