

## **SENATE BILL No. 411**

DIGEST OF SB 411 (Updated January 23, 2020 12:14 pm - DI 119)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

**Synopsis:** Leasing of broadband capacity infrastructure. Urges the legislative council to assign to the interim study committee on energy, utilities, and telecommunications the topic of installation and leasing of broadband capacity infrastructure by investor-owned electric utilities to broadband service providers for the provision of broadband internet service to unserved and underserved areas in Indiana. Specifies issues that must be considered in the study.

Effective: Upon passage.

## SENATE BILL No. 411

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning utilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

CECTION 1 FEEE CTIVE LIDON DACCACEL (a) As a seed in this

2	SECTION, "commission" refers to the Indiana utility regulatory
3	commission created by IC 8-1-1-2.
4	(b) As used in this SECTION, "committee" refers to the interim
5	study committee on energy, utilities, and telecommunications
6	established by IC 2-5-1.3-4(8).
7	(c) As used in this SECTION, "electric utility" means a public
8	utility (as defined in IC 8-1-2-1(a)) that:
9	(1) is an investor owned utility;
10	(2) provides retail electric service to Indiana customers; and
11	(3) is under the jurisdiction of the commission for the
12	approval of rates and charges.
13	(d) As used in this SECTION, "unserved or underserved area"
14	refers to an area in Indiana in which broadband Internet service
15	is not available to all potential customers in the area.



1	(e) The legislative council is urged to assign to the committee the
2	task of studying, during the 2020 legislative interim, the installing
3	and leasing of broadband capacity infrastructure by electric
4	utilities to broadband service providers for the provision of
5	broadband Internet service to unserved and underserved areas in
6	Indiana. If a study is assigned to the committee under this
7	SECTION, the study must include consideration of the following:
8	(1) Whether facilitating the deployment of broadband
9	Internet service to areas of Indiana that are unserved or
10	underserved is in the public interest.
11	(2) The capability of electric utilities to support the
12	deployment of broadband Internet service to unserved and
13	underserved areas in Indiana.
14	(3) The rules and regulations that would be appropriate to
15	provide for leasing of broadband capacity infrastructure to
16	broadband service providers, including preclusion of electric
17	utilities from offering broadband services to retail customers
18	in Indiana.
19	(4) The potential to establish a broadband capacity
20	infrastructure leasing pilot program that would support the
21	deployment of broadband Internet service to unserved and
22	underserved areas in Indiana.
23	(f) This SECTION expires January 1, 2021.
24	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
