SENATE BILL No. 548

DIGEST OF SB 548 (Updated February 20, 2019 10:27 am - DI 104)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Health care expenditure report and recommendation. Requires the office of Medicaid policy and planning to collaborate with the department of insurance and report certain health care expenditure and cost information and recommendations to the legislative council concerning Medicaid. Requires the division of mental health and addiction, with the participation of the criminal justice institute, to provide an executive summary to the legislative council (and, to the extent possible, the standing committees concerning health) concerning the current health payment system and the legal system as each relates to mental health and addiction treatment services provided to individuals against whom criminal charges have been filed or who are incarcerated.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

6 (c) Not later than July 1, 2020, the office, in collaboration with
7 the department of insurance, shall do the following:
8 (1) Report to the legislative council, in an electronic format
9 under IC 5-14-6, the following information with respect to
10 Medicaid:
11 (A) Health care expenditures by major categories for the
12 most recent five (5) years for which the information is
13 available.
14 (B) Key cost drivers and trends.
15 (2) Recommend, in the report under subdivision (1), any
16 legislation and pilot opportunities for a value based health
17 care system to reduce health care costs and enhance price
18 transparency and outcomes, including for long term care.
