## SENATE BILL No. 564

---

DIGEST OF SB 564 (Updated February 19, 2019 5:48 pm - DI 125)

**Citations Affected:** IC 13-23; IC 16-44.

**Synopsis:** Distribution of aviation fuel inspection fees. Provides that inspection fees on aviation fuel must be deposited in the airport development grant fund beginning July 1, 2020. (Current law requires all fuel inspection fees to be deposited in the underground petroleum storage tank excess liability trust fund.) Provides that an airport may not submit a claim for reimbursement from the underground petroleum storage tank excess liability trust fund after June 30, 2020.

**Effective:** July 1, 2019.

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. ## SENATE BILL No. 564

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 13-23-7-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 2019]: **Sec. 11. An airport may not submit a claim for**  
4 **reimbursement from the ELTF after June 30, 2020.**
- 5 SECTION 2. IC 16-44-2-19 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
6 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 19. **(a) Except as**  
7 **provided in subsection (b),** all money collected for inspections under  
8 this chapter shall be deposited in the underground petroleum storage  
9 tank excess liability trust fund established by IC 13-23-7-1.
- 10 **(b) After June 30, 2020, fees collected for inspections of aviation**  
11 **fuel (as defined by IC 6-2.5-5-49) must be transferred to the**  
12 **treasurer of state for deposit in the airport development grant fund**  
13 **established by IC 8-21-11-4.**

Delete the title and insert the following:

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Page 1, delete lines 1 through 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 13-23-7-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: **Sec. 11. An airport may not submit a claim for reimbursement from the ELTF after June 30, 2022.**".

Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
