2	anniversary of the Fischoff National Chamber Music

4	Whereas, In 1973, Joseph E. Fischoff and fellow members
5	of the South Bend Chamber Music Society sought an innovative
6	way of encouraging young people to pursue music study and
7	performance and founded the Fischoff National Chamber
8	Music Association;
9	Whereas, In its first year of existence, the Association
0	began hosting a music competition; six ensembles competed,
1	and 47 years later 130 ensembles competed representing 25
2	different states and 27 nations;
3	Whereas, Today the Fischoff competition is the largest and
4	longest running chamber music competition in the nation;
5	Whereas, Since its founding, more than 7,800 musicians
6	have competed, many of whom have gone on to distinguished
7	careers in music performance and education, including Indiana
8	native and three-time Grammy Award-winning violinist, Joshua
9	Bell, contemporary ensemble, Eighth Blackbird, and the
20	Pacifica Quartet, the 2020 Grammy Award Winner for Best
21	Chamber Music Performance;
22	Whereas, The Fischoff competition distinguishes itself from
23	all other music competitions by remaining true to its core
24	mission: to encourage and educate young musicians in the

1	discipline and expression of chamber music;
2	Whereas, The Fischoff competition partners and alumni
3	have served over 93,500 youth in the tri-state area since 1995
4	and on an annual basis reach more than 4,000 students, many
5	of whom are under-resourced;
6	Whereas, The Fischoff has received local, state, and
7	national recognition and awards, including the National
8	Endowment for the Arts Artworks Grant; the South
9	Bend/Mishawaka Convention and Visitors Bureau Tourism
10	Grant; and the Leighton Award for Nonprofit Excellence from
11	the Community Foundation of St. Joseph County;
12	Whereas, The Fischoff distinguishes itself from all other
13	music competitions by remaining true to its core mission to
14	encourage and educate young musicians in the discipline and
15	expression of chamber music; and
16	Whereas, It is an honor to recognize the Fischoff National
17	Chamber Music Association on its 50th anniversary: Therefore,
