5           *of separatist German Lutherans from Harmony, Pennsylvania;*

6           *Whereas, Over the past 200 years, the town has preserved the*  
7           *spirit and appearance of its unique origins;*

8           *Whereas, New Harmony has remained an oasis of artistic*  
9           *endeavor and small town comfort;*

10           *Whereas, New Harmony has attracted new visitors and spurred*  
11           *economic growth in our state; and*

12           *Whereas, In this year of 2014, New Harmony will celebrate its*  
13           *bicentennial anniversary: Therefore,*

14           *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*  
15           *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:*

16           SECTION 1. That the General Assembly recognizes and honors  
17           the Town of New Harmony, Indiana, on the occasion of its bicentennial
