2 Greenfield Central Cougar Pride Marching Band on placing
3 first in Class B at the Indiana State School Music Association
4 ("ISSMA") State Finals.

5 *Whereas, After receiving the runner-up title in 2018, the*
6 *Greenfield Central Cougar Pride Marching Band earned the*
7 *first place title at the 2019 ISSMA State Finals, which included*
8 *the top 10 Class B marching bands in the State of Indiana;*

9 *Whereas, The Greenfield Central Cougar Pride took the*
10 *field at 11:45 a.m. on November 9th, 2019 at Lucas Oil*
11 *Stadium;*

12 *Whereas, Greenfield Central's road to victory was paved by*
13 *the over 450 hours of rehearsing by the 160 member ensemble;*

14 *Whereas, Greenfield Central's long hours paid off*
15 *throughout the season as the Cougar Pride received caption*
16 *awards at both the Brownsburg and Avon Invitationals for Best*
17 *Percussion, at the Fishers Invitational for Best Visual, Music,*
18 *and Effect, as well as earning a gold rating with distinction in*
19 *both music and effect at the Evansville ISSMA Regional which*
20 *earned the band an advancement to semi-state;*

21 *Whereas, The Cougar Pride performed and perfected*
22 *renditions of "Moonlight Sonata", "Clair de Lune", and "Here*
23 *Comes the Sun" within the 8-minute display titled "The Music*
24 *of the Night";*

1 *Whereas, The ensemble began their theatrical performance*
2 *for this sought after title by lying on the field while the pit*
3 *orchestrated a melodical tune to wake the nocturnal creatures*
4 *in which the members were meant to resemble;*

5 *Whereas, The performance ended on a colorful note when*
6 *the young musicians meticulously demonstrated their immense*
7 *talent by crescendoing into “Here Comes the Sun” ending the*
8 *show on a high note; and*

9 *Whereas, Lead by directors Chris Wing and Jeremy Basso*
10 *along with drum majors Brooklyn Harpold, Paige Johnson, and*
11 *Haley Harper, the Cougar Pride was able to march their way*
12 *to a victory on this seven-month journey to Lucas Oil Stadium*
13 *and earn the Greenfield Central Marching Band’s first state*
14 *finals victory: Therefore,*

15 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*
16 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*
17 *concurring:*

19 congratulates the Greenfield Central Cougar Pride Marching
20 Band on placing first in Class B at the ISSMA State Finals.
