2	"Farmworkers Awareness Week", Cesar Chavez, and the work
3	of Proteus, Inc.
4	Whereas, Indiana's agribusiness employs over 30,000
5	year-round, seasonal and migrant farm workers who are key
6	partners for the safety, security, and sustainability of our
7	food supply;
8	Whereas, The labor of Indiana's farm workers
9	contributes billions of dollars annually to the state's
10	economy, and agriculture continues to be one of the principal
11	industries in the state;
12	Whereas, Indiana honors all those who plant, cultivate,
13	harvest, and process our agricultural products;
14	Whereas, March 31 is the birthday of Cesar Chavez,
15	whose dedication to nonviolent organizing for just wages,
16	safe labor conditions, and the dignity of the women, men, and
17	children who toil in the fields moved him to lead a
18	nationwide peaceful struggle for farm worker justice that
19	continues today;
20	Whereas, Proteus, Inc. is an Iowa-based private,
21	501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that has been serving
22	migrant and seasonal farmworkers, immigrants, and others
23	since 1979;

1	Whereas, In addition to offices in Iowa, Proteus serves a
2	constituency in Indiana and Nebraska;
3	Whereas, Proteus, Inc. was created to help provide
4	communities with health, educational, and economic
5	opportunities;
6	Whereas, To achieve its goals, Proteus strives to make its
7	programs accessible to as many members of the community
8	as possible, embraces diversity in its staff, recipients of its
9	services, program delivery, and in programs as a whole;
10	develops a culture of respect and acceptance in its
11	organization and general community; creates, evaluates, and
12	maintains programs to meet the changing needs of
13	communities; and treats all people in an honest, caring, and
14	respectful manner; and
15	Whereas, The agricultural industry is strong throughout
16	our state, and the strength of the industry's workers continue
17	to keep it great: Therefore,
18	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly
19	of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives
20	concurring:
21	SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly
22	recognizes the efforts of Indiana's farmworkers and their
23	many contributions to the agricultural industry in our state.
24	The members of the Indiana Senate also recognize the
25	contributions of Cesar Chavez and acknowledge him on his
26	birthday. Organizations like Proteus, Inc. help to bring a fair
27	wage and safe and secure working environments to all the
28	members of Indiana's agricultural labor force.
29	SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Senate is hereby
30	directed to transmit a copy fo this Resolution to the Kokomo
31	chapter of Proteus. Inc.
