DIGEST OF INTRODUCED RESOLUTION

Citations Affected: The Seventeenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

Synopsis: Rescind ratification of the Seventeenth Amendment. Rescinds Indiana's ratification of the Seventeenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

4 **States senators by adopting Senate Joint Resolution 3 at its 1913**
5 **regular session (published in Acts 1913, chapter 361, pages 965**
6 **through 966) is hereby rescinded.**
7 SECTION 2. **The governor of Indiana shall send a certified copy**
8 **of this joint resolution to each of the following:**
9 **(1) The Archivist of the United States.**
10 **(2) The Secretary of State of the United States.**
11 **(3) The President of the Senate of the United States.**
12 **(4) The Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United**
