## MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the legislative council to assign
2	to the appropriate committee the topic of raising the age of consent
3	from 16 to 18 years of age.
4	Whereas, The age of consent is the age at or above which
5	a person is considered to have the legal capacity to consent
6	to sexual activity;
7	Whereas, The age of consent in Indiana is 16 years of age;
8	Whereas, It is presumed that before 16 years of age
9	children are not capable legally of consenting to sexual
10	activity;
11	Whereas, It is undeniably true that children form a special
12	and vulnerable group in our society;
13	Whereas, Below a certain minimum age, children are at
14	risk of not having the physiological, biological, and
15	emotional development to cope with sex and the many
16	possible consequences of having sex; and
17	Whereas, The decisions our young people make can affect
18	the rest of their lives; it behooves the state of Indiana to
19	ensure that they are old enough to make the correct decision:
