SENATE RESOLUTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION to urge the legislative council 2 to assign to the appropriate study committee the topic of 3 scholarships for minority students pursuing higher education in 4 the field of health care.

5 Whereas, Numerous studies have documented that there 6 are significant differences in health outcomes and health care 7 quality among racial and ethnic minority groups in the U.S.;

8 Whereas, Health care disparities among minority 9 populations translate into negative health outcomes including; 10 increased mortality rates for African-American women with 11 breast cancer, increased mortality rates for African-American 12 infants, and substantially higher youth mortality rates among 13 Hispanic and African-American children when compared to 14 their Caucasian counterparts;

15 Whereas, Disparities in health care pose a moral and 16 ethical dilemma for minority communities in Hoosier society 17 and threaten to hamper efforts to improve the state's health. 18 Missed diagnoses and poor management of chronic conditions 19 often translate into avoidable, higher costs for health care 20 systems;

Whereas, Diversity in health care providers improves 1 access to health care for underserved populations, leads to 2 increased racial and ethnic minority patient choice and 3 satisfaction, and diversity in educational environments 4 5 improves the quality of education for health professionals, which, in turn improves their ability to treat patients from a 6 wide range of cultural and social backgrounds; 7 8 Whereas, Currently in Indiana, minority higher education students can apply for the William A. Crawford Minority 9 Teacher Scholarship for minority students pursuing a career in 10 education and since 2016, Indiana has distributed 327 of these 11 scholarships totaling \$1,007,594; 12 13 Whereas, The Indiana Legislature should study whether a similar scholarship program for minority students seeking 14 degrees in health professions may help to increase diversity and 15 retain health professionals in Indiana; and 16 Whereas, Indiana must do more to improve diversity among 17 health professionals: Therefore, 18 19 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana: 20 SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate urges the legislative 21 council to assign to the appropriate study committee the topic 22 of scholarships for minority students pursuing higher education 23 in the field of health care. 24
