MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION concerning "advice and
2	consent" for executive appointments.
3	Whereas, The concept of "advice and consent" has been
4	implemented in state and federal governments to provide checks
5	and balances between a legislative and executive branch;
6	Whereas, The members of the Indiana General Assembly
7	are elected to represent and support the interests of Hoosiers
8	in their districts;
9	Whereas, Indiana's governor is responsible for
10	approximately 500 appointments that must be met as set forth
11	in the Indiana Code; and
12	Whereas, Indiana's superintendent of public instruction
13	becomes a secretary of education appointed by the governor in
14	2021: Therefore,
15	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
16	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
17	SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate urges the legislative



l	council to consider proposing an amendment to the Indiana
2	Constitution to include language similar to the following:
3	"All appointments of the governor in state or district
1	office shall be with the advice and consent of two-
5	thirds of the Senate present."
