## **SENATE RESOLUTION**

## MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION honoring the career
2	accomplishments of Max Schumacher.
3	Whereas, Max Schumacher's career with the Indianapolis
4	Indians Minor League Baseball team has spanned a duration
5	of over 60 years, during which time he led the Indians to be
6	widely recognized as one of the most successful and respected
7	baseball franchises in America;
8	Whereas, Mr. Schumacher has been a baseball fan his
9	entire life. Born in Indianapolis during the Great Depression,
10	he grew up with a love of the game instilled in him by his
11	father, who was a member of the Indianapolis Symphony
12	Orchestra and a fan of the game;
13	Whereas, Mr. Schumacher played four years of varsity
14	baseball while also serving as editor of the Collegian
15	publication at Butler University from 1950 to 1954;
16	Whereas, Mr. Schumacher entered the army after
17	graduating from college in 1954, and while he was in service,
18	he discovered there was a job opening with the Indianapolis

1	Whereas, While reading the Indianapolis Star in October
2	1956, Mr. Schumacher noticed a one-paragraph story about the
3	ticket manager leaving the Indianapolis Indians. Shortly
4	thereafter, through his own proactive determination, Mr.
5	Schumacher landed the job as the Indians' ticket manager and
6	began what would become a meaningful lifelong career with
7	the Indianapolis Indians;
8	Whereas, Mr. Schumacher assumed the duties of publicity
9	director in 1959 and took over as general manager just two
10	years later in 1961, serving under then-president Owen J.
11	Bush;
12	Whereas, Following Mr. Bush's retirement in 1969, Mr.
13	Schumacher was named President of the Indianapolis Indians;
14	Whereas, During his tenure as the Indians' general
15	manager, Mr. Schumacher was named the American
16	Association's Executive of the Year for 1996, and just one year
17	later was voted Minor League Baseball's "King of Baseball" for
18	his long-term dedication and service to the game;
19	Whereas, After 60 seasons with the club, Mr. Schumacher
20	transitioned to chairman emeritus in November 2016. In his
21	new role, he will maintain his position on the finance
22	committee, host his suite on game days, and provide mentorship
23	for Indians leadership;
24	Whereas, Under Schumacher's more than half a century of
25	leadership, the Indians have enjoyed recognition for their
26	ongoing commitment to excellence. The team has been
27	recognized with awards such as the Triple-A Bob Freitas
28	Award in 1996 and 2014, Baseball America's Triple-A Team of
29	the Decade for the 1990s, and "At the Yard" magazine's Minor
30	League Baseball Team of the Year in 2005;

Whereas, Mr. Schumacher spearheaded a drive in the mid-

1	1990s to plan, finance, and build a new downtown ballpark
2	which opened on July 11, 1996. The 14,200-seat Victory Field
3	has won designation as "Best Minor League Ballpark" in
4	America;
5	Whereas, The Indians led all of Minor League Baseball in
6	attendance during the 2016 season, one of many records set in
7	the 20-year-old Victory Field;
8	Whereas, Mr. Schumacher has bene inducted into the
9	Butler Athletics Hall of Fame and the Indiana Baseball Hall o
10	Fame and has been named an "Indiana Living Legend" by the
11	Indiana Historical Society;
12	Whereas, Along with his professional success, Mr
13	Schumacher has also been recognized for his impact to the
14	Indianapolis area after formerly serving as President of the
15	Indianapolis Downtown Kiwanis Club, the American Business
16	Club and the Boys & Girls Club of Indianapolis;
17	Whereas, Mr. Schumacher was honored for his numerous
18	contributions with the Thomas W. Moses Good Scout Award in
19	April of 2006 for his dedication to community service, socia
20	responsibility and having a true "scout spirit";
21	Whereas, Mr. Schumacher exemplifies Hoosier integrity
22	and work ethic, having climbed the ranks from ticket manager
23	to President of the Indianapolis Indians through hard work and
24	dedication;
25	Whereas, Mr. Schumacher has made immeasurable
26	contributions to the Indianapolis Indians and the Indianapolis
27	community at large; and
28	Whereas, It is fitting that the Indiana Senate honors Max
29	Schumacher for his career accomplishments, thanks him for his
30	steadfast dedication to the Indianapolis Indians and the



1	Indianapolis community at large, and wishes him health and
2	happiness in the years to come: Therefore,
3	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
4	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
5	SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate honors Max
6	Schumacher for his career accomplishments, thanks him for his
7	steadfast dedication to the Indianapolis Indians and the
8	Indianapolis community at large, and wishes him health and
9	happiness in the years to come.
