AN ACT relating to assistant attorneys general; amending K.S.A. 74-1111 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 74-1111 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-1111. (a) The attorney general shall appoint, with the approval of the board of nursing, an assistant attorney-assistant attorneys general who shall carry out the duties under subsection (b). The attorney-attorneys shall receive an annual salary fixed by the attorney general with the approval of the board of nursing. The salary salaries shall be paid from moneys appropriated to the board of nursing in the board of nursing fee fund.

- (b) The assistant—attorney attorneys general appointed under subsection (a) shall represent the board of nursing in any proceedings or litigation that may arise in the discharge of the duties of the board of nursing and shall perform such other duties of a legal nature as may be directed by the board of nursing.
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-1111 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
