

## Senate Substitute for HOUSE BILL No. 2214

1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to registration fees; electric  
2 and hybrid vehicles; amending K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-143 and repealing  
3 the existing section.

4  
5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-143 is hereby amended to read as  
7 follows: 8-143. (a) All applications for the registration of motorcycles,  
8 motorized bicycles and passenger vehicles other than trucks and truck  
9 tractors, except as otherwise provided, shall be accompanied by an annual  
10 license fee as follows:

11 (1) *Prior to January 1, 2020:*

12 (A) For motorized bicycles, \$11;

13 ~~(B)~~(B) for motorcycles, \$16;

14 ~~(C)~~(C) for passenger vehicles, other than motorcycles, used solely for  
15 the carrying of persons for pleasure or business, and for hearses and  
16 ambulances a fee of:

17 ~~(A)~~(i) For those having a gross weight of 4,500 pounds or less, \$30;  
18 and

19 ~~(B)~~(ii) for those having a gross weight of more than 4,500 pounds,  
20 \$40.

21 ~~(D)~~(D) Except for motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers registered  
22 under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,134, and amendments thereto, the  
23 annual registration fee for each motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer owned  
24 by any political or taxing subdivision of this state or by any agency or  
25 instrumentality of any one or more political or taxing subdivisions of this  
26 state and used exclusively for governmental purposes and not for any  
27 private or utility purposes, ~~which~~ *that* is not otherwise exempt from  
28 registration, shall be \$2.

29 (2) *On and after January 1, 2020:*

30 (A) For motorized bicycles, \$11;

31 (B) for motorcycles, \$16;

32 (C) for passenger vehicles, other than motorcycles, used solely for  
33 the carrying of persons for pleasure or business, and for hearses and  
34 ambulances a fee of:

35 (i) For those having a gross weight of 4,500 pounds or less, \$30;

36 (ii) for those having a gross weight of more than 4,500 pounds, \$40;

1 (iii) for those motor vehicles that are conventional electric hybrid  
2 and plug-in electric hybrid vehicles, \$50; and

3 (iv) for those motor vehicles that are all-electric vehicles, \$100.

4 (D) Except for motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers registered  
5 under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,134, and amendments thereto, the  
6 annual registration fee for each motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer  
7 owned by any political or taxing subdivision of this state or by any agency  
8 or instrumentality of any one or more political or taxing subdivisions of  
9 this state and used exclusively for governmental purposes and not for any  
10 private or utility purposes, that is not otherwise exempt from registration,  
11 shall be \$2.

12 (b) (1) As used in this subsection, the term "gross weight" shall mean  
13 and include the empty weight of the truck, or combination of the truck or  
14 truck tractor and any type trailer or semitrailer, plus the maximum weight  
15 of cargo which will be transported on or with the same, except when the  
16 empty weight of a truck plus the maximum weight of cargo which will be  
17 transported thereon is 12,000 pounds or less. The term gross weight shall  
18 not include: The weight of any travel trailer propelled thereby which is  
19 being used for private recreational purposes; or the weight of any vehicle  
20 or combination of vehicles for which wrecker or towing service, as defined  
21 in K.S.A. 66-1329, and amendments thereto, is to be provided by a  
22 wrecker or tow truck, as defined in K.S.A. 66-1329, and amendments  
23 thereto. Such wrecker or tow truck shall be registered for the empty weight  
24 of such vehicle fully equipped for the recovery or towing of vehicles. The  
25 gross weight license fees hereinafter prescribed shall only apply to the  
26 truck or truck tractor used as the propelling unit for the cargo and vehicle  
27 propelled, either as a single vehicle or combination of vehicles. On  
28 application for the registration of a truck or truck tractor, the owner thereof  
29 shall declare as a part of such application the maximum gross weight the  
30 owner desires to be applicable to such vehicle, which declared gross  
31 weight in no event shall be in excess of the limitations described by K.S.A.  
32 8-1908 and 8-1909, and amendments thereto, for such vehicle or  
33 combination of vehicles of which it will be a part. All applications for the  
34 registration of trucks or truck tractors, except as otherwise provided  
35 herein, shall be accompanied by an annual license fee as follows:

2 (2) If the applicant for registration of any truck or truck tractor for a  
3 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds ~~is~~ in the state of Kansas or any  
4 political or taxing subdivision or agency of the state, except a city or  
5 county, whose truck or truck tractor is not otherwise entitled to the \$2  
6 license fee or otherwise exempt from all fees, such vehicle may be  
7 licensed for a fee in accordance with the schedule hereinafter prescribed  
8 for local trucks or truck tractors.

9 (3) If the applicant for registration of any truck or truck tractor for a  
10 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds shall under oath state in writing  
11 on a form prescribed and furnished by the director of vehicles that the  
12 applicant does not expect to operate it more than 6,000 miles in the  
13 calendar year for which the applicant seeks registration, and that if the  
14 applicant shall operate it more than 6,000 miles during such registration  
15 year such applicant will pay an additional fee equal to the fee required by  
16 the schedule under paragraph (1), less the amount of the fee paid at time of  
17 registration, such vehicle may be licensed for a fee in accordance with the  
18 schedule prescribed for local trucks or truck tractors. Whenever a truck or  
19 truck tractor is registered on a local truck or truck tractor fee basis a tab or  
20 marker shall be issued in connection with the regular license plate, which  
21 tab or marker shall be attached or affixed to and displayed with the regular  
22 license plate and the failure to have the same attached, affixed or displayed  
23 shall be subject to the same penalties as provided by law for the failure to  
24 display the regular license plate; and the secretary of revenue may adopt  
25 rules and regulations requiring the owners of trucks and truck tractors so  
26 registered on a local truck or truck tractor fee basis to keep such records  
27 and make such reports of mileage of such vehicles as the secretary of  
28 revenue shall deem proper.

29 (4) A transporter delivering vehicles not the transporter's own by the  
30 driveaway method where such vehicles are being driven, towed, or  
31 transported singly, or by the saddlemount, towbar, or fullmount methods,  
32 or by any lawful combination thereof, may apply for license plates which  
33 may be transferred from one such vehicle or combination to another for  
34 each delivery without further registration, and the annual license fee for  
35 such license plate shall be as follows:

2 (5) A truck or truck tractor registered for a gross weight of more than  
3 12,000 pounds, ~~which~~ *that* is operated wholly within the corporate limits  
4 of a city or village or within a radius of 25 miles beyond the corporate  
5 limits, shall be classified as a local truck except that in no event shall such  
6 vehicles operated as contract or common carriers outside a radius of three  
7 miles beyond the corporate limits of the city or village in which such  
8 vehicles were based when registered and licensed be considered local  
9 trucks or truck tractors. The secretary of revenue is hereby authorized and  
10 directed to adopt rules and regulations prescribing a procedure for the  
11 issuance of permits by the division of vehicles whereby owners of local  
12 trucks or truck tractors may operate any such vehicle, empty, beyond the  
13 radius hereinbefore prescribed, when such operation is solely for the  
14 purpose of having such vehicle repaired, painted or serviced or for adding  
15 additional equipment thereto. The annual license fee for a local truck or  
16 truck tractor, except as otherwise provided herein, shall be as follows:

2 A vehicle licensed as a farm truck or truck tractor may be used by the  
3 owner thereof to transport, for charity and without compensation of any  
4 kind, commodities for religious or educational institutions. A truck ~~which~~  
5 *that* is licensed as a farm truck may also be used for the transportation of  
6 sand, gravel, slag stone, limestone, crushed stone, cinders, black top, dirt  
7 or fill material to a township road maintenance or construction site of the  
8 township in which the owner of such truck resides. Any applicant for  
9 registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor used in combination  
10 with a trailer or semitrailer shall register the farm truck or farm truck  
11 tractor for a gross weight which shall include the empty weight of the  
12 truck or truck tractor or of the combination of any truck or truck tractor  
13 and any type of trailer or semitrailer, plus the maximum weight of cargo  
14 ~~which that~~ will be transported on or with the same. The applicant for  
15 registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor used to transport a  
16 gross weight of more than 54,000 pounds shall durably letter on the side of  
17 the motor vehicle the words "farm vehicle—not for hire." If an applicant  
18 for registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor operates such  
19 vehicle for any use or purpose not authorized for a farm truck or farm  
20 truck tractor, such applicant shall pay an additional fee equal to the fee  
21 required for the registration of all trucks or truck tractors not registered as  
22 local, 6,000-mile or farm truck or farm truck tractor motor vehicles, less  
23 the amount of the fee paid at time of registration. Nothing in this or the  
24 preceding paragraph shall authorize a gross weight of a vehicle or  
25 combination of vehicles on the national system of interstate and defense  
26 highways greater than permitted by laws of the United States congress.

4 Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, shall be \$2.

5 (8) For licensing purposes, station wagons with a carrying capacity of  
6 less than 10 passengers shall be subject to registration fees based on the  
7 weight of the vehicles, as provided in subsection (a). Station wagons with  
8 a carrying capacity of 10 or more passengers shall be subject to the truck  
9 classifications and license fees as provided.

10 (9) For any trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer or pole trailer the annual  
11 license fee shall be as follows:

12 (A) ~~(i) Until January 1, 2013, for any such vehicle with a gross~~  
13 ~~weight of more than 12,000 pounds the annual fee shall be \$35;~~

14 ~~(ii) on January 1, 2013, For any such vehicle with a gross weight of~~  
15 ~~more than 12,000 pounds but less than 54,000 pounds the annual fee shall~~  
16 ~~be \$45, on January 1, 2014, \$55;~~

17 (B) any such vehicle grossing more than 8,000 pounds but not over  
18 12,000 pounds, the annual fee shall be ~~\$25, on January 1, 2013, \$35, on~~  
19 ~~January 1, 2014, \$45;~~

20 (C) for any such vehicle grossing more than 2,000 pounds but not  
21 over 8,000 pounds, the annual fee shall be ~~\$15, on January 1, 2013, \$25,~~  
22 ~~on January 1, 2014, \$35.~~

23 Any such vehicle having a gross weight of 2,000 pounds or less may, at  
24 the owner's option, be registered and the fee for such registration shall be  
25 as provided in paragraph (C).

26 Any trailer, semitrailer or travel trailer owned by a nonresident of this  
27 state and based in another state, ~~which that~~ is properly registered and  
28 licensed in the state of residence of the owner or in the state where based,  
29 may be operated in this state without being registered or licensed in this  
30 state if the truck or truck tractor propelling the same is properly registered  
31 and licensed in this state, or is registered and licensed in some other state  
32 and is entitled to reciprocal privileges of operation in this state, but this  
33 provision shall not apply to any trailer or semitrailer owned by a  
34 nonresident of this state when such trailer or semitrailer is owned by a  
35 person who has proportionately registered and licensed a fleet of vehicles  
36 under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,101 ~~to through~~ 8-1,123, ~~inclusive,~~ and  
37 amendments thereto, or under the terms of any reciprocal or proration  
38 agreement made pursuant thereto.

39 At the option of the owner, any trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer, with a  
40 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds, may be issued a multi-year  
41 registration for a five-year period upon payment of the appropriate  
42 registration fee. The fee for a five-year registration of such trailer shall be  
43 five times the annual fee for such trailer. If the annual registration fee is

1 increased during the multi-year registration period, the owner of the trailer  
2 with such multi-year registration shall be subject to the amount of the  
3 increase of the annual registration fee for the remaining calendar years of  
4 such multi-year registration. When the owner of any trailer, semitrailer or  
5 pole trailer registered under this multi-year provision transfers or assigns  
6 the title, or interest thereto, the registration of such trailer shall expire. The  
7 owner shall remove the license plate from such trailer and forward the  
8 license plate to the division of vehicles or may have such license plate  
9 assigned to another trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer upon the payment of  
10 fees required by law. Any owner of a trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer  
11 where the multi-year registration fee has been paid and the trailer is sold,  
12 junked, repossessed, foreclosed by a mechanic's lien or title transferred by  
13 operation of law, and the registration thereon is not going to be transferred  
14 to another trailer, may secure a refund for the registration fee for the  
15 remaining calendar years by making application to the division of vehicles  
16 on a form and in the manner prescribed by the director of vehicles. The  
17 secretary of revenue may adopt such rules and regulations necessary to  
18 implement the multi-year registration of such trailers, semitrailers and pole  
19 trailers.

20 (c) Any truck or truck tractor having a gross weight of 4,000 pounds  
21 or over, using solid tires, shall pay a license fee of double the amount  
22 herein charged. The annual fees herein provided for trucks, truck tractors  
23 and trailers not subject to K.S.A. 8-134a, and amendments thereto, shall be  
24 due January 1 of each year and payable on or before the last day of  
25 February in each year. If the fee is not paid by such date a penalty of \$1  
26 shall be added to the fee charged herein for each month or fraction thereof  
27 and until December 31 of each registration year. The annual registration  
28 fee for all passenger vehicles and vehicles subject to K.S.A. 8-134a, and  
29 amendments thereto, shall be due on or before the last day of the month in  
30 which the registration plate expires and shall be due for other vehicles as  
31 provided by K.S.A. 8-134, and amendments thereto. If the registration fee  
32 is not paid by such date a penalty of \$1 shall be added to the fee charged  
33 herein for each month or fraction thereof until such registration fee is paid.  
34 Members of the armed forces of the United States shall be permitted to  
35 apply for registration at any time and be subject to registration fee, less  
36 penalties, applicable at the time the application is made. If any motorcycle,  
37 motorized bicycle, trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer, or pole trailer is either  
38 purchased or acquired after the anniversary or renewal date in any  
39 registration year there shall immediately become due and payable a  
40 registration fee as follows: If purchased or acquired between the  
41 anniversary or renewal date of any registration year and the first six  
42 months of such registration year, the annual fee ~~herein~~ before provided  
43 *herein*; if purchased or acquired during the last six months of any

1 registration year, 50% of such annual fee. If any truck or truck tractor,  
2 except trucks subject to K.S.A. 8-134a, and amendments thereto, is  
3 purchased or acquired prior to April 1 of any year the fee shall be the  
4 annual fee ~~hereinbefore~~ provided *herein*, but if such truck or truck tractor  
5 is purchased or acquired after the end of March of any year, the license fee  
6 for such year shall be reduced  $\frac{1}{12}$  for each calendar month which has  
7 elapsed since the beginning of the year. If any truck registered for a gross  
8 weight of 12,000 pounds or less or passenger vehicle is purchased or  
9 acquired and less than 12 months remain in the registration period, the fee  
10 shall be  $\frac{1}{12}$  of the annual fee for each calendar month remaining in the  
11 registration period.

12 (d) The owner of any motorcycle, motorized bicycle, passenger  
13 vehicle, truck, truck tractor, trailer, semitrailer, or electrically propelled  
14 vehicle who fails to pay the registration fee or fees herein provided on the  
15 date when the same become due and payable shall be guilty of a  
16 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a penalty in  
17 the sum of \$1 for each month or fraction thereof during which such fee has  
18 remained unpaid after it became due and payable; and in addition thereto  
19 shall be subject to such other punishment as is provided in this act. Upon  
20 the transfer of motorcycles, motorized bicycles, passenger vehicles,  
21 trailers, semitrailers, trucks or truck tractors, on which registration fees  
22 have been paid for the year in which the transfer is made, either: (1) To a  
23 corporation by one or more persons, solely in exchange for stock or  
24 securities in such corporation; or (2) by one corporation to another  
25 corporation when all of the assets of such corporation are transferred to the  
26 other corporation, then in either case, *paragraph (1) or—case (2)* the  
27 corporation shall be exempt from the payment of registration fees on such  
28 vehicles for the year in which such transfer is made. Applications for  
29 transfer or registration shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1.50. When the  
30 registration of a vehicle has expired at midnight on the last day of any  
31 registration year, and such vehicle is not thereafter operated upon the  
32 highways, any application for renewal of registration made subsequent to  
33 the anniversary or renewal date of any registration year following the  
34 expiration of such registration and for succeeding registration years in  
35 which such vehicle has not been registered shall be accompanied by an  
36 affidavit of nonoperation and nonuse, and such application for renewal or  
37 registration shall be received by the division of vehicles upon payment of  
38 the proper fees for the current registration year and without penalty.

39 (e) Any nonresident of Kansas purchasing a vehicle from a Kansas  
40 resident and desiring to secure registration on the vehicle in the state of  
41 such person's residence may make application in the office of any county  
42 treasurer for a sixty-day temporary registration. The county treasurer upon  
43 presentation of evidence of ownership in the applicant and evidence the

1 sales tax has been paid, if due, shall charge and collect a fee of \$3 for each  
2 sixty-day temporary license and issue a sticker or paper registration as may  
3 be determined by the director of vehicles, and the registration so issued  
4 shall be valid for a period of 60 days from the date of issuance.

5 (f) Any owner of any motor vehicle ~~which~~ *that* is subject to taxation  
6 under the provisions of article 51 of chapter 79 of the Kansas Statutes  
7 Annotated, and amendments thereto, or any other truck or truck tractor  
8 where the annual registration fee has been paid and the vehicle is sold,  
9 junked, repossessed, foreclosed by a mechanic's lien or title transferred by  
10 operation of law, and the registration thereon is not going to be transferred  
11 to another vehicle may secure a refund for the registration fee for the  
12 remaining portion of the year by making application to the division of  
13 vehicles on a form and in the manner prescribed by the director of  
14 vehicles, accompanied by all license plates and attachments issued in  
15 connection therewith. If the owner of the registration becomes deceased  
16 and the vehicle is not going to be used on the highway, and title is not  
17 being currently transferred, the proper representative of the estate shall be  
18 entitled to the refund. The refund shall be made only for the period of time  
19 remaining in the registration year from the date of completion and filing of  
20 the application with and delivery of the license plate and attachments to  
21 the division of vehicles. Where the registration is secured under a quarterly  
22 payment annual registration fee, as provided for in K.S.A. 8-143a, and  
23 amendments thereto, such refund shall be made on the quarterly fee paid  
24 and unused and all remaining quarterly payments shall be canceled. Any  
25 truck or truck tractor having the registration fee paid on quarterly payment  
26 basis, all quarterly payments due or a fraction of quarterly payment due  
27 shall be paid before title may be transferred, except that in case of death,  
28 the filing of the application and returning of the license plate and  
29 attachment shall cancel the remaining annual payments due. Whenever a  
30 truck or truck tractor, where the registration is secured on a quarterly  
31 payment of the annual registration, the one repossessing the truck or truck  
32 tractor, or foreclosing by a mechanic's lien, or securing title by court order,  
33 the mortgagor or the assigns of the mortgagor, or the one securing title  
34 may pay the balance due on date of application for title, but the payments  
35 for the remaining portion of the year shall not be canceled unless  
36 application is made and the license plate and attachments are surrendered.  
37 Nothing in this subsection shall apply when registration is secured under  
38 the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,101 ~~to through~~ 8-1,123, ~~inclusive~~, and  
39 amendments thereto. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing provisions of  
40 this section, no refund shall be made under the provisions of this section  
41 where the amount thereof does not exceed \$5. The division of vehicles  
42 shall furnish such blank forms as may be required under the provisions of  
43 this subsection as it deems necessary to be completed by the applicant.

1 Whenever a registration which has been secured on a quarterly basis shall  
2 be canceled as provided in this subsection, the division of vehicles shall  
3 notify the county treasurer issuing the original registration of such  
4 cancellation so that the county treasurer may, and the county treasurer shall  
5 cancel the registration of such vehicle in the county treasurer's office and  
6 release any lien issued in connection with such registration.

7 (g) Every owner of a travel trailer designed for or intended to be  
8 moved upon any highway in this state shall, before the same is so moved,  
9 apply for and obtain the proper registration thereof as provided in this act,  
10 except when such unit is permitted to be moved under the special  
11 provisions relating to secured parties, manufacturers, dealers and  
12 nonresidents contained in this act. At the time of registering any travel  
13 trailer for the purpose of moving any such vehicle upon any highway in  
14 this state, the owner thereof shall indicate on the registration form whether  
15 or not such vehicle is being moved permanently to a location outside of the  
16 county in which such vehicle is being registered. No such vehicle which  
17 the owner thereof intends to move to a permanent location outside the  
18 boundaries of such county shall be registered for movement on the  
19 highways of this state until all taxes levied against such vehicle have been  
20 paid. A copy of such registration form shall be sent to the county clerk or  
21 assessor of the county to which such vehicle is being moved. When such  
22 travel trailer is used for living quarters and not operated on the highways,  
23 the owner shall be exempt from the license fees as provided in subsection  
24 (b)(9) so long as such travel trailer is not operated on the highway.
