1 AN ACT concerning the department of health and environment, relating
2 to school-located influenza vaccination programs.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) The Kansas department of health and
6 environment shall apply for federal grants and appropriations under the
7 federal patient protection and affordable care act, public law 111-148, and
8 amendments thereto, to fund, promote and expand school-located
9 influenza vaccination programs to provide seasonal influenza
10 vaccinations for school-aged children.

11 (b) The Kansas department of health and environment shall seek
12 grants and appropriations from the following sources:

13 (1) Community transformation grants for the promotion of healthy
14 living and reduction of racial and ethnic disparities pursuant to section
15 4201 of the federal patient protection and affordable care act;

16 (2) the prevention and public health fund for prevention and public
17 health initiatives pursuant to section 4002 of the federal patient protection
18 and affordable care act;

19 (3) funding for public health promotion outreach and education
20 programs to encourage preventative care services pursuant to section
21 4004 of the federal patient protection and affordable care act;

22 (4) funding for demonstration projects to test wellness initiatives in
23 the individual insurance market pursuant to section 1201 of the federal
24 patient protection and affordable care act; and

25 (5) any other federal or private funding and grant opportunities for
26 influenza prevention and vaccination.

27 (c) The Kansas department of health and environment shall make
28 information regarding federal grant and appropriations opportunities
29 under the federal patient protection and affordable care act, available to
30 the public by publishing such information on the state department's
31 website.

32 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
33 publication in the statute book.
