1 AN ACT concerning compensation of legislators during the regular
2 sessions of the legislature.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. On the effective date of this act, notwithstanding the
6 provisions of K.S.A. 46-137a, and amendments thereto, and except as
7 provided further, no member of the legislature shall receive the per diem
8 compensation provided for in K.S.A. 46-137a(a), and amendments thereto,
9 for more than 70 days during any regular session of the legislature, unless
10 legislation that provides for a budget for the ensuing fiscal year is passed
11 by the legislature during such regular session of the legislature and
12 presented to the governor. The revisor of statutes shall be responsible for
13 certifying to the director of legislative administrative services if or when
14 such legislation has been passed and presented to the governor. Upon
15 receipt of such certification, the director of legislative administrative
16 services shall authorize compensation for legislators for the remainder of
17 such regular session of the legislature. If, during any regular session of the
18 legislature, the legislature passes and enacts into law a budget for two
19 ensuing fiscal years, then, at the next preceding regular session of the
20 legislature, members of the legislature shall receive the per diem
21 compensation provided for in K.S.A. 46-137a(a), and amendments thereto,
22 for such regular session of the legislature.

23 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
24 publication in the Kansas register.
