PURPOSE OF MEASURE: The purpose of this measure is to provide a local government the ability to levy a special ad valorem tax rate for funding the public library located in the local government's library district.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: HB 477 does not have a state fiscal impact. The bill allows a local government the ability to levy a special ad valorem tax rate upon taxable property located in its jurisdictional boundaries. The bill does not impact state revenues or expenditures.

*KRS 6.945 may apply and any fiscal impact upon cities would be addressed in a local mandate.
