1	AN ACT relating to implementing Do Not Resuscitate orders in a hospital setting.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 311 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) For purposes of this section, "Do Not Resuscitate or DNR order" means a
6	medical order directing that life-prolonging treatment as defined in KRS 311.621
7	is not to be provided to a patient.
8	(2) A Do Not Resuscitate or DNR order written by any health care provider in a
9	hospital setting shall not be implemented without the signature of the patient or a
10	family member of the patient.
11	(3) If a patient for whom a Do Not Resuscitate or DNR order has been written by any
12	health care provider in a hospital setting does not have a current "MOST,
13	Medical Order for Scope of Treatment" form completed in accordance with KRS
14	311.621 to 311.643, a hospital may request, but shall not require, that the patient
15	or other authorized person complete a "MOST, Medical Order for Scope of
16	Treatment" form in accordance with KRS 311.621 to 311.643.
