6	<u>(1)</u>	For purposes of this section:
7		(a) "Authority" means the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority;
8		(b) "Full enrollment space amount" means the difference between the out-of-
9		state and in-state tuition amount at a public participating veterinary school
10		or an equivalent amount determined by the authority for a nonpublic
11		participating veterinary school;
12		(c) "Kentucky student" means a Kentucky resident as determined by the
13		authority using the criteria established by the Council on Postsecondary
14		Education for the purposes of postsecondary admission and tuition
15		assessment;
16		(d) "Participating veterinary school" means a college of veterinary medicine
17		approved by the authority for participation in the program; and
18		(e) "Program" means the Veterinary Contract Spaces Program.
19	<u>(2)</u>	The General Assembly establishes the Veterinary Contract Spaces Program to
20		provide financial assistance and access to Kentucky students seeking a veterinary
21		education and to help ensure the availability of a sufficient veterinary workforce
22		in the Commonwealth.
23	<u>(3)</u>	The authority shall administer the program and shall promulgate administrative
24		regulations in accordance with KRS Chapter 13A as may be needed for the
25		administration of the program.
26	<u>(4)</u>	Subject to the availability of funds, the authority shall contract to purchase at
27		least one hundred sixty-four (164) enrollment spaces annually for Kentucky

I		students at one (1) or more participating veterinary schools. To the extent
2		possible, the contract shall be for the full enrollment space amount.
3	<u>(5)</u>	Kentucky students enrolled in a participating veterinary school and selected by
4		the school for participation in the program shall receive a tuition credit from the
5		school in the amount required to purchase his or her enrollment space each
6		semester, not to exceed eight (8) semesters.
7	<u>(6)</u>	To the extent possible, the authority shall secure enrollment spaces so that
8		Kentucky students participating in the program may continue applying tuition
9		credits at the same participating veterinary school for up to eight (8) semesters.
10	<u>(7)</u>	(a) The Veterinary Contract Spaces Program trust fund is hereby created as a
11		trust fund in the State Treasury to be administered by the authority for the
12		purpose of purchasing enrollment spaces for Kentucky students in
13		participating veterinary schools as described in this section.
14		(b) The trust fund shall consist of state general fund appropriations, gifts and
15		grants from public and private sources, and federal funds. All moneys
16		included in the fund shall be appropriated for the purposes set forth in this
17		section.
18		(c) Any unalloted or unencumbered balances in the trust fund shall be invested
19		as provided in KRS 42.500(9). Income earned from the investments shall be
20		credited to the trust fund.
21		(d) Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any fund balance at the close of the fiscal
22		year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward to the next fiscal year and
23		continuously appropriated only for the purposes specified in this section.
