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- AN ACT relating to financial literacy.

2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

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→ Section 1. KRS 158.1411 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) Beginning with the entering ninth grade class of the 2020-2021 school year and
 5 each year thereafter, successful completion of *at least a one-half (1/2) credit*6 *course*[one (1) or more courses or programs] that *meets*[meet] the financial literacy
 7 *academic* standards shall be a Kentucky public high school graduation requirement.
 8 The graduation requirement shall also apply to a student pursuing an early
 9 graduation program, as established in KRS 158.142.
- 10 (2) In accordance with KRS 156.160, the Kentucky Board of Education shall
 promulgate administrative regulations establishing academic standards and a
 graduation requirement for financial literacy.
- 13 (3) The local school-based decision making council, or principal if no council exists, of
 14 each high school shall determine curricula for course offerings, programs, or a
 15 combination of course offerings and programs that are aligned with the financial
 16 literacy academic standards promulgated by the Kentucky Board of Education.
- 17 (4) The Department of Education shall develop financial literacy guidelines that
 18 provide direction to local schools in developing and implementing the financial
 19 literacy standards.
