

1 AN ACT relating to the renewal of identity documents.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 186.4101 (Effective January 1, 2019) is amended to read as
4 follows:

- 5 (1) ***(a)*** A license to operate a motor vehicle, motorcycle, or moped ***issued under KRS***
6 ***186.412 or a personal identification card issued under KRS 186.4122*** shall
7 be renewed every eight (8) years prior to its expiration.
- 8 ***(b)*** Except as provided in KRS 186.410, ~~and~~ 186.4121, ***and 186.4123***, a person
9 seeking to renew an operator's license ***or personal identification card*** shall
10 apply at the office of the circuit clerk in the county where the person resides in
11 accordance with KRS 186.412.
- 12 (2) In order to accommodate the transition from a four (4) year licensing schedule to an
13 eight (8) year licensing schedule, the Transportation Cabinet may, during the first
14 four (4) years after January 1, 2019, renew operator's licenses and personal
15 identification cards with terms of both four (4) and eight (8) years.
- 16 (3) ***(a)*** ***Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, the holder of an***
17 ***operator's license issued under KRS 186.412 or a personal identification***
18 ***card issued under KRS 186.4122 may apply to renew the document up to six***
19 ***(6) months in advance of its expiration date.***
- 20 ***(b)*** ***An individual whose operator's license was issued pursuant to KRS***
21 ***186.412, and who will be out of the country on the date the license is due to***
22 ***expire, may apply to renew the operator's license in advance of the***
23 ***individual's departure, even if the departure date is more than six (6)***
24 ***months prior to the license's expiration.***
- 25 ***(4)*** The fee to renew an operator's license shall be according to the schedule set forth in
26 KRS 186.531.
