4		agreement, leasing, or otherwise exchanging services or goods with a state agency

6		accepting a state entitlement fund disbursement;

8	(16)	"Appointing authority" means the agency head or any person whom he or she has
9		authorized by law to act on behalf of the agency with respect to employee
10		appointments;
11	(17)	"Represent" means to attend an agency proceeding, write a letter, or communicate
12		with an employee of an agency on behalf of someone else;
13	(18)	"Directly involved" means to work on personally or to supervise someone who
