A JOINT RESOLUTION directing the Transportation Cabinet to erect a sign on United States Route 27 in Lincoln County that proudly proclaims Lincoln County as the Home of McKenzie Settles, 2018 NASP/IBO 3D State Archery Champion.

WHEREAS, McKenzie Settles is a freshman at Lincoln County High School in Stanford, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, McKenzie Settles competed in the 2018 National Archery in the Schools Program/International Bowhunting Organization (NASP/IBO) State Championships at the Kentucky Exposition Center in Louisville; and

WHEREAS, in the sport of 3D archery, the goal is to shoot at various close to lifesized animal-shaped foam targets with scoring rings on them; and

WHEREAS, McKenzie Settles shot a 293 out of a possible 300 and scored 24 10s to sweep the girls individual state titles in the NASP/IBO 3D Challenge; and

WHEREAS, McKenzie Settles' score was the best out of 180 high school girls, first out of 60 ninth-grade girls, and first out of 408 girls overall; and

WHEREAS, McKenzie Settles placed fourth overall among all 3D Challenge archers and was one of only two females to place in the top 10 of both girls and boys combined; and

WHEREAS, this honorable body hereby congratulates McKenzie Settles for winning the 2018 NASP/IBO 3D State Archery title and grants her best wishes as she continues both her education and her archery career;

NOW, THEREFORE,

## Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

$\rightarrow$ Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to honor McKenzie Settles by erecting a sign on United States Route 27 at the Boyle County/Lincoln County line that reads, "Home of McKenzie Settles, 2018 NASP/IBO 3D State Archery Champion." The sign shall be erected within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, and shall remain in place for at least one year from the date of its placement.
