| 5  | WHEREAS, the founders of the Constitution of the United States empowered state                |
| 6  | legislatures to be guardians of liberty against future abuses of power by the federal         |
| 7  | government; and   |
| 8  | WHEREAS, the federal government has created a crushing national debt through                  |
| 9  | improper and imprudent spending; and  |
| 10 | WHEREAS, the federal government has invaded the legitimate roles of the states                |
| 11 | through the manipulative process of federal mandates, most of which are unfunded to a         |
| 12 | great extent; and   |
| 13 | WHEREAS, the federal government has ceased to live under a proper interpretation              |
| 14 | of the Constitution of the United States; and   |
| 15 | WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of the states to protect the liberty of our people,            |
| 16 | particularly for the generations to come, by proposing amendments to the Constitution of      |
| 17 | the United States through a convention of the states under Article V of the Constitution      |
| 18 | for the purpose of restraining these and related abuses of power;                             |
| 19 | NOW, THEREFORE,   |
| 20 | Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:                       |
| 21 | →Section 1. The Congress of the United States is hereby petitioned to propose an              |
| 22 | amendment to the Constitution of the United States, for submission to the states for          |
| 23 | ratification, to impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, and to limit the federal |
| 24 | government's power and jurisdiction.  |
| 25 | →Section 2. Pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United States, the               |
| 26 | Legislature of the State of Kentucky joins in the applications of the states of Georgia (SR   |

27 736, 2014), Florida (SM 476, 2014), Alaska (HJR 22, 2014), Alabama (HJR 112, 2015),

1 Tennessee (SJR 67, 2016), Indiana (SJR 14, 2016), Oklahoma (SJR 4, 2016), Louisiana 2 (SCR 52, 2016), Texas (SJR 2, 2017), Missouri (SCR 4, 2017), North Dakota (HCR 3006, 2017), and Arizona (HCR 2010, 2017) for a convention for the specific and 3 4 exclusive purpose of proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States 5 limited to the purposes stated therein; provided, however, the commissioners from 6 Kentucky to the convention are expressly limited to consideration and support of 7 amendments that impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, and amendments that 8 limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and no other amendments on 9 any topic whatsoever.

Section 3. It is the express intention of the General Assembly that this
application shall be aggregated with the subsequent applications of other states limited to
the purposes identified in this application, and with those applications of the abovementioned states.

Section 4. This application constitutes a continuing application in accordance
with Article V of the Constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at least
two-thirds of the several states have made applications for a similar convention under
Article V, or the General Assembly acts to withdraw this application.

Section 5. The Secretary of State shall transmit certified copies of this Joint
 Resolution to the President and Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and
 Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, the presiding officer in each house
 of the legislature in each of the states in the union, and to the members of Kentucky's
 congressional delegation requesting their cooperation.
