3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 72 IS CREATED TO
5	READ AS FOLLOWS:
6	(1) The coroner shall ensure that the remains of a police officer, firefighter, or
7	emergency medical services personnel, as defined in KRS 61.315, killed in the
8	line of duty are returned to the care and custody of that person's family or other
9	party responsible for the person's final arrangements in a casket or other similar
10	vessel. The casket or vessel shall be covered by an American flag.
11	(2) The fiscal court, or legislative body of an urban-county government, charter
12	county government, consolidated local government, or unified local government
13	shall be responsible for any costs associated with obtaining the flag and casket or
14	similar vessel for transporting the police officer, firefighter, or emergency
15	medical services personnel under subsection (1) of this section.
16	(3) Nothing in this section shall be construed as requiring the fiscal court, or
17	legislative body of an urban-county government, charter county government,
18	consolidated local government, or unified local government, to purchase the flag
19	to remain in the permanent custody of the family or other party responsible for
20	the police officer's, firefighter's, or emergency medical services personnel's final
21	arrangements, or to purchase the casket or similar vessel for the permanent
22	interment or cremation, or other final and permanent disposition of the remains
23	of the police officer, firefighter, or emergency medical services personnel.
