1	AN ACT relating to the storage of firearms.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 199.420 TO 199.670 IS CREATED
4	TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, "home study" means an evaluation of a home
6	environment conducted by a public agency or child-placing agency which
7	documents the suitability of the home for the placement of a child in foster care,
8	adoptive care, relative caregiver services, fictive kin care, or other residential
9	alternative.
10	(2) The Cabinet for Health and Family Services shall promulgate administrative
11	regulations to establish the process, procedures, and requirements to ensure that,
12	prior to placement of a child under the age of sixteen (16):
13	(a) Every home study conducted certifies that all adult household members:
14	1. Keep all firearms present in the home or the home's curtilage in
15	securely locked containers which prevent the child from gaining
16	access to the firearms; or
17	2. Equip each firearm with a device or mechanism designed to prevent
18	the discharge of the firearm by unauthorized users; and
19	(b) Written information on the requirements of this section is presented to all
20	adult household members, and receipt of the information is acknowledged
21	in writing.
