1	AN ACT relating to employees of quasi-governmental agencies.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 18A IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, "quasi-governmental agency" means an entity:
6	(a) Created by government to service the public interests, but which maintains a
7	legally separate status; and
8	(b) That participates in the Kentucky Retirement Systems.
9	(2) An employee of a quasi-governmental agency who began participating in the
10	systems administered by Kentucky Retirement Systems prior to January 1, 2014,
11	and whose agency voluntarily ceases participation and elects to not continue
12	participating in the system after the cessation date pursuant to KRS 61.522 shall
13	be given interview preference when applying for competitive classified positions
14	for which the employee meets the minimum qualifications established for the job
15	<u>classification.</u>
16	(3) (a) Applicants entitled to interview preference as set forth in this section shall
17	be clearly identified.
18	(b) 1. If the number of applicants identified under paragraph (a) of this
19	subsection is less than five (5), the employing agency shall offer an
20	interview to all applicants identified under paragraph (a) of this
21	subsection.
22	2. If the number of applicants identified under paragraph (a) of this
23	subsection equals or exceeds five (5), the employing agency shall offer
24	an interview to no fewer than five (5) applicants.
25	(4) Interview preference shall only apply to applicants seeking initial appointment to
26	the classified service.
