1	AN ACT relating to cancer prevention through insurance coverage for screening
2	and appropriate genetic testing.
3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4	→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF SUBTITLE 17A OF KRS CHAPTER 304
5	IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
6	(1) As used in this section, "genetic test for cancer risk" means a blood, saliva, or
7	tissue typing test that reliably determines the presence or absence of an inherited
8	genetic characteristic that is generally accepted in the medical or scientific
9	community as being associated with a statistically significant increased risk of
10	<u>cancer development.</u>
11	(2) (a) All health benefit plans issued or renewed on or after the effective date of
12	this Act shall cover any genetic test for cancer risk that is recommended by
13	any of the following, if the recommendation is consistent with the most
14	recent version of genetic testing guidelines published by the National
15	Comprehensive Cancer Network (NCCN):
16	1. A physician, physician assistant, or genetic counselor licensed under
17	KRS Chapter 311; or
18	2. An advanced practice registered nurse licensed under KRS Chapter
19	<u>314.</u>
20	(b) The commissioner may extend the coverage required by paragraph (a) of
21	this subsection to include recommendations that are consistent with the
22	most recent version of genetic testing guidelines or criteria published by
23	additional national medical societies, if the guidelines or criteria are
24	determined by the commissioner to be relevant and reliable.
25	(3) Coverage required by this section shall:
26	(a) Not be subject to a deductible, coinsurance, or any other cost-sharing
27	requirements; and

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1		(b) Include coverage at the health benefit plan's average in-network rate for
2		out-of-network providers or laboratories if there are no in-network
3		providers or laboratories available to provide the covered test.
4	<u>(4</u>)	This section shall not be construed to limit coverage required by Section 2 of this
5		Act or any other law.
6		→Section 2. KRS 304.17A-257 is amended to read as follows:
7	(1)	A health benefit plan issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2016, shall provide
8		coverage for all colorectal cancer examinations and laboratory tests specified in <u>the</u>
9		most recent version of the[current] American Cancer Society guidelines for
10		complete colorectal cancer screening of asymptomatic individuals as follows:
11		(a) Coverage or benefits shall be provided for all colorectal <u>cancer[screening]</u>
12		examinations and <i>laboratory</i> tests that are administered at a frequency
13		identified in the most recent version of the American Cancer Society
14		guidelines for complete colorectal cancer screening; and
15		(b) The covered individual shall be:
16		1. <u>Forty-five (45)</u> [Fifty (50)] years of age or older; or
17		2. Less than <i>forty-five (45)</i> [fifty (50)] years of age and at high risk for
18		colorectal cancer according to the most recent version of the current
19		colorectal cancer screening guidelines of the] American Cancer Society
20		guidelines for complete colorectal cancer screening.
21	(2)	Coverage <u>required by</u> {under} this section shall not be subject to a deductible ₁ [or}
22		coinsurance, or any other cost-sharing requirements for services received from
23		participating providers under the health benefit plan.
24	<u>(3)</u>	This section shall not be construed to limit coverage required by Section 1 of this
25		Act or any other law.
26		\rightarrow Section 3. This Act takes effect on January 1, 2020.
