1		AN ACT relating to grain discounts.
2	Be it	enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3		→ Section 1. KRS 251.015 is amended to read as follows:
4	<u>(1)</u>	The Division of Regulation and Inspection is established within the Office for
5		Consumer and Environmental Protection of the Department of Agriculture. The
6		division shall be headed by a director appointed by the Commissioner who shall be
7		responsible for administering the provisions of this chapter and any administrative
8		regulations promulgated in accordance with this chapter.
9	<u>(2)</u>	The Department of Agriculture may investigate grain discounts, which are buyer-
10		imposed reductions to the price per bushel of grain due to any real or perceived
11		grain quality deficiencies.
12	<u>(3)</u>	The Department of Agriculture or its agents or employees shall have free access
13		within reasonable hours to any farm, garden, elevator, warehouse, building,
14		cellar, freight or express office or car, freight yard, vehicle, vessel, boat,
15		container, or any other place which, for probable cause, it may be necessary or
16		desirable for the agents to enter in order to conduct an investigation under
17		subsection (2) of this section.
18	<u>(4)</u>	Any person who hinders, obstructs, or interferes with inspectors while they are
19		discharging their duties under subsection (2) of this section shall be fined not less
20		than fifty dollars (\$50) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100) per violation.
21	<u>(5)</u>	The Department of Agriculture shall report its findings on investigations relating
22		to grain discounts to the Legislative Research Commission and the Interim Joint
23		Committee on Agriculture by November 1 of each year.
