1	AN ACT relating to strangulation.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 508 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) A person is guilty of strangulation when the person, without consent and other
6	than as part of a legitimate medical or dental procedure, wantonly impedes the
7	normal breathing or circulation of the blood of another person, regardless of
8	whether the conduct results in any visible physical injury, by:
9	(a) Applying pressure on the throat or neck of the other person; or
10	(b) Blocking the nose or mouth of the other person.
11	(2) Strangulation is a Class D felony.
