

1 AN ACT relating to deficient administrative regulations.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 13A IS CREATED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 *(1) The General Assembly finds that certain administrative regulations as evidenced*
6 *by the records of the Legislative Research Commission, including but not limited*
7 *to the Kentucky Administrative Regulations Service and the Administrative*
8 *Register of Kentucky, were found deficient but became effective notwithstanding*
9 *the finding of deficiency, pursuant to KRS 13A.330, on or after April 15, 2020,*
10 *and before January 5, 2021, and were found deficient pursuant to KRS 13A.336*
11 *including:*

12 *(a) 803 KAR 2:180, Labor Cabinet, Department of Workplace Standards,*
13 *Recordkeeping, reporting, statistics;*

14 *(b) 921 KAR 3:025, Cabinet for Health and Family Services, Department of*
15 *Community Based Services, Technical Requirements; and*

16 *(c) 921 KAR 3:025E, Cabinet for Health and Family Services, Department of*
17 *Community Based Services, Technical Requirements, Emergency.*

18 *(2) Contrary provisions of any section of the Kentucky Revised Statutes*
19 *notwithstanding, each administrative regulation referenced in subsection (1) of*
20 *this section shall be null, void, and unenforceable as of the effective date of this*
21 *Act.*

22 *(3) Contrary provisions of any section of the Kentucky Revised Statutes*
23 *notwithstanding, the administrative body shall be prohibited from promulgating*
24 *an administrative regulation that is identical to, or substantially the same as, any*
25 *of the administrative regulations referenced in subsection (1) of this section for a*
26 *period beginning on March 30, 2021, and concluding on June 1, 2022.*

27 *(4) A list of the administrative regulations referenced in subsection (1) of this section*

- 1 *shall be available to the public, in the office of the Legislative Research*
- 2 *Commission's regulations compiler.*
