2	Be it	enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO
4	REA	D AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year and each school year thereafter, every
6		public school shall provide developmentally appropriate instruction on child
7		abuse and child sexual abuse to students in kindergarten through grade twelve
8		<u>(12).</u>
9	(2)	The instruction shall be provided as part of a health, physical education, or other
10		course or during another designated classroom period or time during the school
11		day as determined by the school council or the principal, if no school council
12		exists.
13	(3)	The Kentucky Department of Education shall develop child abuse and child
14		sexual abuse instructional guidelines and resources that may be utilized by the
15		school to provide the instruction required under this section.
16	<u>(4</u>)	The requirements of this section shall apply to public charter schools as a health
17		and safety requirement under KRS 160.1592(1).
18		→ Section 2. This Act may be cited as Jenna Quinn's Law.
