- 17 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of 18 Kentucky:
- → Section 1. The members of the Senate encourage all citizens to recognize the achievements of audiologists and speech-language pathologists in improving the quality of life for people with communication disorders.
- Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor and recognition of this Commonwealth's audiologists and speech-language pathologists.
