11 Russel burg, who finished first in the 152-pound division; Stephen Little, who finished
12 second in the 160-pound division; Micah Ervin, who finished first in the 170-pound
13 division; and Matthias Ervin, who finished first in the 220-pound division; and

15 wrestling team upon capturing their 11th KASHA state championship, acknowledges the
16 hard work of Head Coach Robert Ervin and his staff for their extraordinary mentorship,
