3	WHEREAS, Kentucky has established itself as an auto manufacturing hub, ranking
4	third in the country in passenger vehicle production; and
5	WHEREAS, Bowling Green is home to the General Motors Corvette Assembly
6	Plant, the only place in, not only the nation, but the world where the iconic Corvette is

8	WHEREAS, the all-new Chevrolet Corvette Stingray has been named the 2020
9	North American Car of the Year by a 50-member jury of independent automotive
10	journalists; and
11	WHEREAS, production of the 2020 model will begin next month here in the
12	Commonwealth with customer deliveries taking place shortly thereafter; and
13	WHEREAS, the Corvette was previously honored with this award in 1998 for the
14	introduction of the fifth-generation vehicle and again in 2014 for its seventh-generation
15	model;
