

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of 10-year-
2 old Benjamin Lockett, who lost his life while rescuing his six year old sister, Abigail.

3 WHEREAS, it is prudent that this august body honor those heroes who risk their
4 lives to save others; and

5 WHEREAS, 10 year old Benjamin Lockett of Millington, Tennessee, is one such
6 hero, and his courageous and selfless acts are duly recognized by this body today; and

7 WHEREAS, on February 14, 2021, Benjamin Lockett and his siblings were playing
8 at a pond near their home when Abigail, only six years old, fell into the frigid water.
9 Benjamin immediately jumped in to save his little sister; and

10 WHEREAS, Benjamin Lockett perished during this incident, and all in this body
11 stand in solemn reverence for his soul; and

12 WHEREAS, in so doing, the members posthumously honor Benjamin Lockett for
13 his uncommon bravery and heroism, and grant the entire Lockett family including little
14 Abigail, who is doing well, best wishes and God's divine comfort in their time of loss;

15 NOW, THEREFORE,

16 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
17 ***Kentucky:***

18 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate, individually and collectively, hereby
19 honor Benjamin Lockett for his heroic acts on February 14, 2021, and extend profound
20 sympathy to the Lockett family on this day.

21 ➔Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor and loving
22 memory of Benjamin Lockett.
