WORKERS' COMPENSATION. Provides for continuation of the weekly death benefit for the surviving spouse upon remarriage when a law enforcement officer was killed in the line of duty. (8/1/20)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Requires that the decedent who was employed as a law enforcement officer must have been killed in the line of duty for benefits to continue.

Fields

<u>Present law</u> regarding workers' compensation, provides weekly death benefits to a surviving spouse who was actually living with the decedent at the time of injury or death or was dependent on the decedent for support.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the workers' compensation weekly death benefit payments continue until death or remarriage of the surviving spouse.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides an exception for the surviving spouse of a law enforcement officer, who was killed in the line of duty, to allow workers' compensation weekly death benefits to continue after remarriage.

Effective August 1, 2020.
