## CRIMINAL/TRIALS: Provides relative to court-martial proceedings

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 29:152(A), relative to the military forces of the state; to provide
3	relative to military justice; to provide for disciplinary proceedings of service
4	members; to provide relative to trial procedure; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 29:152(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§152. Article 52. Number of votes required
8	A. No person may be convicted of an offense, except as provided in Article
9	45(B) or by the concurrence of two-thirds a unanimous vote of the members present
10	at the time the vote is taken.

Abstract: Changes the number of votes required for a conviction for an offense in courtmartial proceedings.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Louisiana Code of Military Justice which applies to all members of the state military forces.

Present law provides for military disciplinary proceedings.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains present law and changes the number of votes required for a conviction for an offense from 2/3 of the members present at the time the vote is taken to a unanimous vote.
