2	To amend and reenact R.S. 56:116.1(B)(3), relative to methods of taking certain birds and
3	quadrupeds; to provide for prohibited equipment used to take game birds and wild
4	quadrupeds; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 56:116.1(B)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§116.1. Wild birds and wild quadrupeds; times and methods of taking; penalties
8	* * *
9	B. No person shall do any of the following:
10	* * *
11	(3) Take or kill any game bird or wild quadruped with a firearm fitted with
12	any device to deaden or silence the sound of the discharge thereof; or fitted with an
13	infrared sight, electrically operated <u>laser</u> sight <u>or except as provided in Paragraph</u>
14	(A)(8) of this Section any sighting device which projects a beam of light to the target
15	or otherwise electronically illuminates the target, or device specifically designed to
16	enhance vision at night; or with or by means of an automatic loading or hand
17	operated repeating shotgun capable of holding more than three shells. Any shotgun
18	capable of holding more than three shells shall be plugged with a one-piece filler

1	incapable of removal through the loading end, so as to reduce the capacity of the gun
2	to not more than three shells at one loading.
