Section 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the appropriations in 2 Section 1 of this Act are deemed bona fide obligations of the state through June 30, 2025. 3 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 4 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 5 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 6 7 effective on the day following such approval.
