Abstract: Expands the definition of "construction aggregates" to include dirt.

<u>Present law</u> defines "construction aggregates" as any of the following: sand, gravel, crushed stone, reef shell, clam shell, sand-clam shell mixture, sand-reef shell mixture, sand clay gravel, clam-reef shell mixture, crushed concrete, expanded clay, calcium sulfate hemihydrate, and asphalt.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands the definition of "construction aggregates" to include dirt.
